



## Chaperones Service Hours

- Two chaperones are required per team per overnight tournament.
- BAVA will pay for the chaperone's room.
- A background check through Anne Arundel County is required.
- Coaches are in charge of the players when they are on the court. Chaperones are in charge of the players whenever they are off the court
- Coaches will let the chaperones know what time and where to meet for meals and going to play sites
- Chaperones have the final say about "off the court" time. Please report to the coaches there are any behavior problems in the hotel/dorm.
- Chaperones should monitor activity in the hotel, including bedtime and monitoring noise levels. Quiet hours are 11pm to 6am.
- Parents are not allowed to take their kids and do whatever they want. There may be some down time (depending on when your team plays)...it is up to the chaperones if you allow the kids to go by themselves with their parents.
- Always arrange a meeting time and place for the players to meet you and make sure they have your cell phone number.
- Club rule: the players must stay in at least groups of 3 (the 13's and 14's teams might want stricter rules), especially if they venture outside the hotel for shopping or sightseeing.
