



Scorekeeping Service Hours

- * Attend the scorekeeping/referee clinic held in December or January.
- * Learn how to keep score so you can monitor the work tables and help the girls keep score during tournaments (if they need it).
- * Coordinate players' certification process.
 - Create a list of who is currently certified and who needs to attend a clinic.
 - Please make sure there are at least 3-5 players on your team that plan completing the certification process.
